Treasurer Report

2018 we had a record number of households paying dues! 71 out of 154 homes paid their dues 2018. That's 14 more than the previous year. Thank you to all those who have paid. Your support of the neighborhood has allowed the association to once again protect itself with liability insurance and resume some maintenance of the common land. With continued support we can continue our work to maintain the ball field and re-claim the tennis/basketball court.

The SPEA bank account balance is currently at \$3,745.14.

Insurance has been paid. The next expenses to be paid are the taxes (\$833.72 a year), the required water testing of the pond (about \$500.00) and the website hosting fee (\$11.99 per month). Invoices for the 2019 dues will be mailed out by May1st and will be due by June 1st

 transferred to a MRF (Materials Recovery Facility), where they are separated and prepared for reuse at
 end-user manufacturers.
